Updates on the Carnival Archive Project!

New Collections

The Carnival Archive Project, funded by Heritage Lottery Fund, is all about collecting. We have continued to engage with various community groups in Luton and have recently added new collections to our Archive.

The first collection is from the Luton Irish Forum which documents the St. Patricks Day Parade in Luton. We have also added collections from 2 Carnival groups based in Luton: Sickle Cell Group and St. Kitts and Nevis. The final collection are costume sketches and designs by Colin Spalding, member of the Rampage group and a renown Carnival designer in Luton.

LUTON IRISH FORUM COLLECTION

We have been working with the Luton Irish Forum, collecting images, pictures, newsletters and newspaper articles documenting the St. Patrick's Day Parade in Luton since 1993 to 2012. The Luton Irish Forum is also working on *Catching the Boat*, a Heritage Lottery Funded project which aims to document the contribution of settlers from Ireland to life in Luton. The Irish community will be encouraged to get involved by sharing their personal memories.

SICKLE CELL GROUP COLLECTION

The Sickle Cell Group collection documents the group's involvement in Luton Carnival since 2005, looking at the early costumes and the development and growth of the group throughout the years. It also showcases the whole costume-making process from beginning to end.
